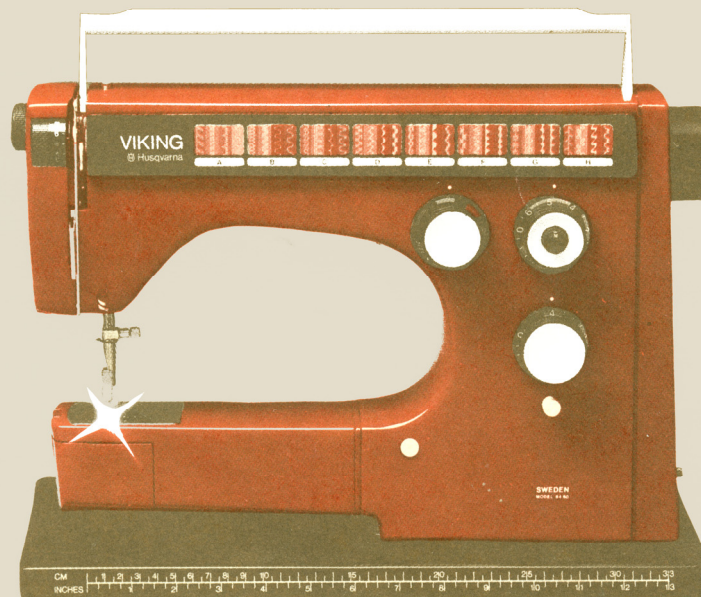
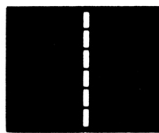

Zig-zag

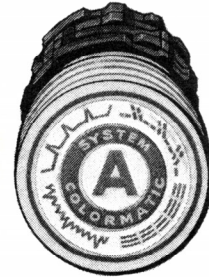


Three-step zig-zag

Utility stitches on



Overlock stitch

Sews a stretchable seam and finishes the seam allowance in one operation. Ideal for narrow, supple seams in jersey, knitteds, stretch towelling for swimwear etc. and similar fabrics. Saves time when attaching collars, cuffs, etc.



Elastic straight stitch

A triple straight stitch which holds where an ordinary straight stitch breaks. Indispensable for stretch fabrics, bias sewing and for all seams where special strength is needed, like crotch seams and for arm openings.



Elastic blindstitch

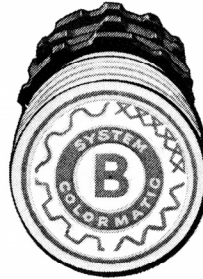
For use with all knit and stretch fabrics. Gives a stretchable and almost invisible hem.



Blind hem stitch

For quick and easy hemming of garments in non-stretch fabric. The stitches are practically invisible from the right side.

Utility stitches on



Double overlock

Sews and finishes seams in one operation. Suitable for fabrics with a moderate amount of “stretch” as well as for non-stretch materials. The overlock seam binds the yarns of the fabric, which makes it ideal for overcasting coarse, rough textured materials and fabrics that tend to fray



Ric Rac

For prominent top stitching and for appliqué work using cloth tape (bias strips), for fabrics with a selvedge or folded edge or for leather.



Double-action stitch

For joining seams, overcasting and making decorative hems in soft fabrics.



Serpentine

For darning and mending, for sewing lycra, elastic and knitwear.

Utility stitches on



Shirring stitch

For gathering over shirring elastic. Use the button-hole presser foot and put the elastic around the projection at its "heel". Sew over both lengths of elastic to give a gathered decorative effect.



Point de Paris hemstitch

For decorative hems on linens and fine fabrics. Also appliqués, particularly leather.



Bridging stitch

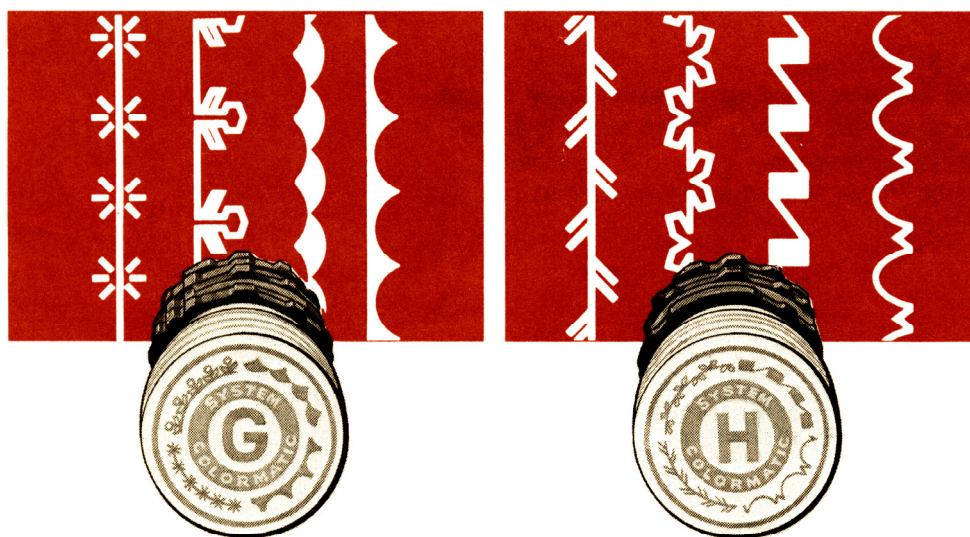
For joining two pieces of fabric with folded edges creating a decorative effect at the same time. Also suitable for inserting lace, and for sewing and mending in girdle and swimsuit fabric.



Overcast stitch

For simultaneous seaming and overcasting in lingerie and other sheer fabrics.
