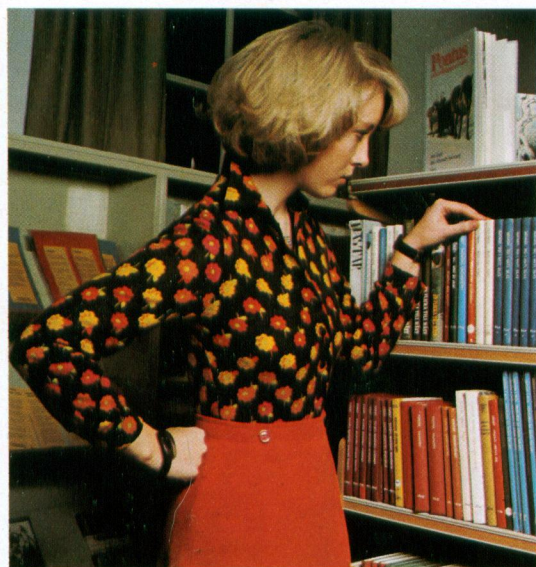
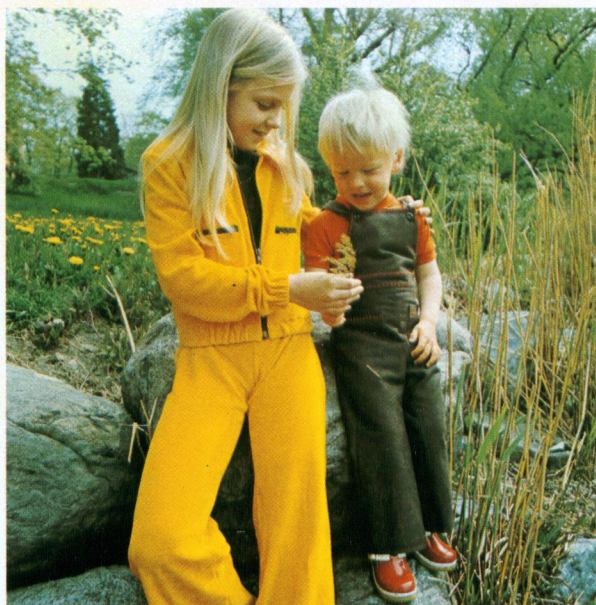

The elastic straight stitch holds where an ordinary straight stitch breaks. Indispensable for stretch fabrics, bias sewing and for seams where special strength is needed, like crotch seams and arm openings on these children's sports outfits.



The overlock stitch joins and overcasts in one action. Ideal for narrow supple seams in double-knit, sweater fabric, swimsuit fabric and similar materials. A real time saver when attaching collars and cuffs.



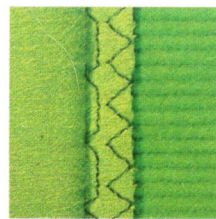
Quick buttonholes like the ones on this girl's woolen suit are made with the Viking's special buttonhole stitch, without turning the fabric.



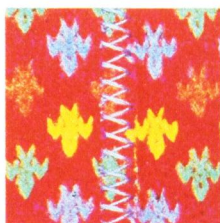

Blind hem stitch for quick, easy hemming of garments like this girl's corduroy suit. On the right side of the fabric the stitch is invisible.



Three-step zig-zag was used for overcasting.



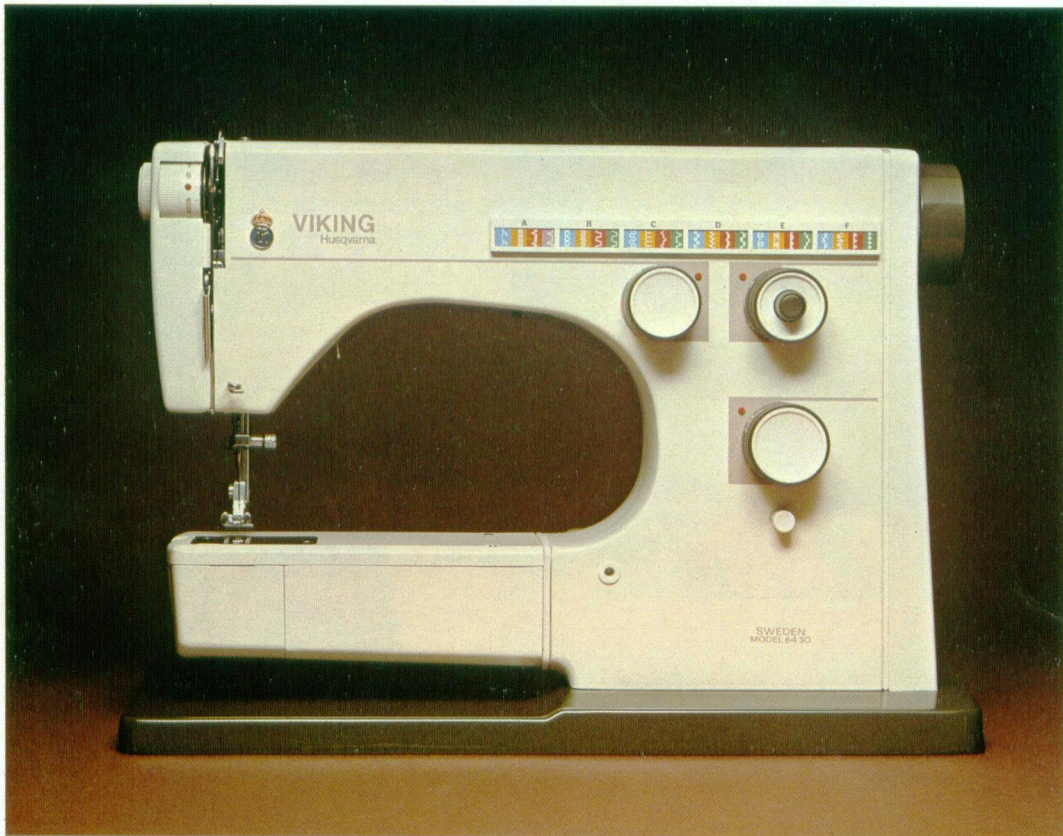
Double overlock sews a stretchable seam and finishes it in one operation. Suitable for fabrics with a moderate amount of "stretch" as well as for non-stretch materials. The overlock seam binds the yarns of the fabric extremely well, which makes it ideal for overcasting rough textured, fuzzy materials and fabrics that tend to fray.



Sew everything from lingerie to leather. Viking enables you to sew in the material of your choice. Even elegant accessories like these leather handbags can be sewn with ease thanks to the Viking's combination of exclusive features like the slow running gear and professional stitches. Specially useful for leather are the **Ric Rac** for top stitching and the **Point de Paris hem stitch**.
